From a 15-year-old vineyard on sandy soil. Partial carbonic maceration; then 8 months in oak barrels.

On the label: Lester Horton (1906-1953). American dancer known for his unlimited, dramatic freedom of expression, using a variety of dance techniques, from Native American to Japanese styles. (MIRA was herself a ballet dancer)
