**2011 Domaine de Poulvarel Costieres de  
Nimes Perrottes**

My favorite in the lineup, the 2011 Costieres De Nimes Perrottes is a superb blend of 70% Syrah and 30% Grenache that spent 15 months in a combination of older barrels (1-3 years in age) and concrete. Medium to full-bodied, gorgeously textured and pure, with notions of mint, currants, spice and underbrush, it opens up nicely in the glass, has a savory, expansive mouth feel and chewy tannin on the finish. It-s a rocking value and should continue to drink nicely for 3-5 years.
